Consultation on our Relationships and Sex Education Policy

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are writing to inform you that our draft Relationships and Sex Education Policy is now open for parent and carer consultation.

Relationships and Sex Education, often referred to as RSE, is an important part of the curriculum. It helps children to understand healthy relationships, friendships, families, respect, personal boundaries, keeping safe, growing and changing, and how to seek help when needed. At primary school, this is taught in an age-appropriate and sensitive way, supporting children to develop the knowledge and confidence they need as they grow.

Our RSE Policy sets out how this area of the curriculum is taught at Stanbury Village School. It explains the aims of RSE, the content covered across year groups, how lessons are delivered, how we ensure teaching is inclusive and appropriate, and the role of parents and carers in supporting this area of learning.

Consultation is important because we value the views of our school community. It gives parents and carers the opportunity to read the draft policy, understand our approach, and share any feedback before the policy is finalised and approved by governors.
