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

Dear Parents and Carers,

We are delighted to announce that we have launched a new reading scheme in Key Stage 2. This will really improve our reading provision – the quality of books that the children will be bringing home will dramatically improve. The new scheme is banded by colour and the children have all completed a short 'assessment' to match them to a book band.

The reading scheme directly aligns with the phonics scheme we use in Foundation Stage and Key Stage 1. Ensuring we build effectively on the skills and knowledge learnt in EYFS and KS1 as children move into Key Stage 2. The scheme contains a variety of fiction and non-fiction books including a variety of modern and current themes to engage our children. See the list below for some example:
