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## Celebrating Our Outstanding Key Stage 2 Results

Dear Parents and Carers,

I am absolutely delighted to share the fantastic results achieved by our Year 6 pupils in this year's Key Stage 2 statutory assessments. These are our strongest results for three years and represent a tremendous achievement for everyone involved.

Our pupils achieved:

- Reading: 92% reached the expected standard
- Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling: 84% reached the expected standard
- Mathematics: 76% reached the expected standard

The national results published today show that 75% of pupils achieved the expected standard in reading, 74% in Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling and 75% in mathematics. This means that Stanbury's results surpassed the national averages in all three subjects, by an exceptional 17% in reading and 10% in Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling.

We are equally proud of the number of pupils achieving the higher standard, demonstrating an advanced level of knowledge, skill and understanding:

- 53% achieved the higher standard in reading
- 14% achieved the higher standard in mathematics
- 7% achieved the higher standard in Grammar, Punctuation and Spelling

The reading result is particularly remarkable, with more than half of the cohort achieving the higher standard. This reflects the children's enthusiasm for reading and the strong culture of reading that has been developed throughout our school.

These results are even more significant when we remember that this group of children experienced considerable disruption to their early education during the pandemic, particularly



towards the end of Reception and throughout Year 1. Their resilience, determination and positive attitude have been truly inspiring.

Of course, a child's success can never be measured by test results alone. We are equally proud of the kind, confident and thoughtful young people our Year 6 pupils have become. Nevertheless, these results deserve to be celebrated and are a wonderful reflection of their commitment and hard work.

I would like to offer my heartfelt congratulations to every pupil. I would also like to thank the Class 3 Team and all the staff who have taught, encouraged and supported the children throughout their time at Stanbury. These outcomes are the result of years of dedicated teaching and teamwork across the school.

Finally, thank you to our parents and families for the invaluable encouragement and support you have provided at home. We are incredibly fortunate to have such a supportive school community.

This is an achievement of which the whole Stanbury family can be immensely proud. Well done, Year 6, you have truly excelled!
