Antí-bullyíng week

We will be launching national anti-bullying week in school on Monday with 'Odd Sock Day'. We are encouraging everyone to come to school in odd socks to show that we value difference and celebrate our uniqueness. This year the theme for anti-bullying week is 'Make a noise about bullying', we will be focusing on what bullying means to us, how banter can turn into something more hurtful, and what we all can do to stop bullying. We want everyone to know that together, we can make a difference and take a stand against bullying.

Cross country

This term children from across our junior classes have had the opportunity to compete against other schools in cross country events. The first was at Kenninghall Primary School, Mrs Pilmer took a squad of 48 children (the fastest boys and girls from each class) to compete for our school and a number of children came back wearing medals having come in the top three of their races. The fastest three boys and girls in each year group, then qualified to race at Langley School on the 1st November in the South Norfolk competition. Our school came 9th overall in this event, out of 25 schools, which was a considerable achievement given the size of many of the schools that were competing. The weather was cold and rainy but this did not deter our runners who all did a great job representing our school. Certificates were also awarded at the end of the event to children that had embodied the theme of the event; 'striving to be our best selves'. Mrs Pilmer selected Elsie in year four and Ebony in year six as both girls strove to give their very best during the event (despite adversity). Well done to everyone that took part—you were all great sporting ambassadors for our school.

Our next cross country event will be the Santa Dash on Friday 8th December, when all of the children will compete for the house led by their team captains.

School dinners

If your child has any diagnosed food allergies or intolerances and you wish for them to have school dinners, parents are required to complete a Food allergies form and return this to Norse (our school meal provider). Once Norse have agreed to provide a specific menu (such as gluten free) for a child, then children can only be given food from the allergy free menu to ensure that the food they are given is safe for them to eat. Copies of the allergy form can be provided by the school office.

Please could we also remind families that we are a nut free school, and no foods including nuts, should be eaten on the school premises as we have children with nut allergies. Thank you.
