

# Covid-19

We have seen a rise in cases of Covid-19. You are no longer required to do a Covid-19 rapid lateral flow test if you have symptoms. But if you or your child have tested positive for COVID-19, this is the guidance from the NHS website:

- try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 3 days after the day the test was taken if you or your child are under 18 years old
- try to stay at home and avoid contact with other people for 5 days after the day you took your test if you are 18 years old or over
- avoid meeting people who are more likely to get seriously ill from viruses, such as people with a weakened immune system, for 10 days after the day you took your test

The next Forest School session will take place on **Thursday 28**<sup>th</sup> **September with Year 3.** The class will need to come to school in non-uniform and have wellington boots, a good waterproof coat and plenty of layers.
