Year 6 SATS

Year 6 will sit their SATS (Standard Assessment Tests) the week beginning Monday 11th May. **It is important that your child is in school every day.** Your child is used to doing this type of assessment so is nothing to worry about. We do ask that all children are on time to school and get an early night to be fully prepared. Children need to be at school for 8.45am, the usual start of the school day; we currently have a few children arriving at 9am, this is late and children are missing vital revision. On these four mornings, we will be providing your child with a sausage, bacon or veggie sausage buttie and a glass of fresh orange or milk. 😊

- Monday, May 11th: English grammar, punctuation, and spelling (Papers 1 and 2).
- Tuesday, May 12th: English reading.
- Wednesday, May 13th: Mathematics (Papers 1 and 2).
- Thursday, May 14th: Mathematics (Paper 3).

Year 4 Multiplication Check

Year 4 will sit the online Multiplication check during the week beginning **1st June**. Your child is used to doing this type of assessment so is nothing to worry about but extra practice on TT Rockstars would be very beneficial. **It is important that your child is in school every day.**

Year 1 Phonics Screen Check

Year 1, and some children who did not meet the expected standard last year, now in Y2 will sit the Phonics Screen check during the week beginning Monday 8th June. Your child is used to doing this type of assessment so is nothing to worry about. **It is important that your child is in school every day.**

Breakfast Club and Dinner Money

Reminder: Dinner Money and Breakfast Club MUST be paid for in advance. All children MUST be signed in by an adult on the register for Breakfast Club each morning as this is before school provision and we will have no log of your child being in school on this day unless signed in.
