For what next year holds in store.

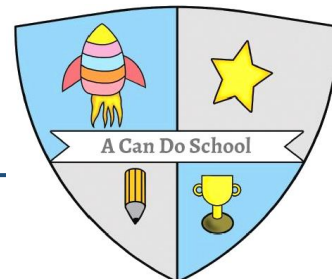
I'll remember all the fun we had
