Another thank you - to all of you who sent in cakes for the bake sale. We raised an impressive £350! The proceeds of this will go towards our school dog, Winston.

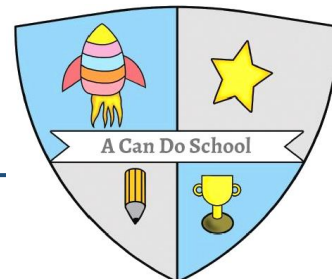

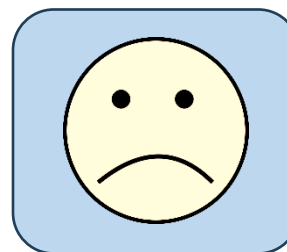
