Next week in detail!

Next week is a busy week with lots on so I thought I would take the opportunity to write in detail about the major events.

Wednesday 8th July

We are delighted to welcome our SIAMS inspector to look at our effectiveness as a Church School. The Inspector will spend the day with us speaking to governors, staff and children. She would also like to hear from parents and carers. Whilst she will be on the gate and you are welcome to approach her (or email in!), I am looking for a few parents who would be willing to speak to her in more detail from 3pm on the day. Questions will relate to our Biblical vision and values and the impact of our work in this area. During the day on Wednesday, we will also be holding a practice for Sports Day so all children in the school should come to school in PE kit.

Thursday 9th July - Transition Day

Year 4 children will go directly to their new schools and spend the day with them. We wish them all well.

All other children will spend the day in their new classes and will enter and exit from their new classrooms areas. Nursery (9-11am) will enter and leave via the Nursery entrance. Reception children (8.40-1.15) will come through the main gates and into the playground and enter the classroom near the wooden boat. Year 1 children will walk past the wooden boat and under the walkway that connects the two buildings to the furthest door on the right. Years 2,3 and 4 will enter the doors on the top playground to the (soon to be formerly known as) Key Stage 2 building. Children working in the Hub, will enter the current Year 2 area next to the Reception door. Children in Years 1,2,3 and 4 can be collected at 3.20pm as normal.

I will be on hand in the morning to direct you and signs will be up showing you where to go and where your afternoon collection points are. Please ask if you are unsure.

Friday 10th July - Sports Day and Open Morning

Children should wear the correct PE kit to school - white t-shirt, red shorts, trainers and no earrings. Hats and water bottles should also be brought to school. Children will not need to bring their Book Bag.

School will open at 8am for parents and carers to make use of the delicious offerings of Reggie's Diner. If arriving early, children should stay with you. At 8.40am a whistle will be blown and children should go quickly to their classrooms for registration. We ask that parents and carers then take their seats opposite their child's team. Children will be wearing a sticker on Wednesday that tells you which team they are in. Parents and carers are welcome to bring seats and blankets to sit on. We do ask, if bringing a seat, you sit towards the back of your group so you do not obscure the view for others.

The gates will close at 8.50am and Sports Day will start as close to 9am as possible. If you have family members that need to arrive a little later, please direct them to the main office.

During Sports Day, we ask that you do not cross the tracks to see your children. If there is a problem, please come and visit me at the scoring table and we will get a message across. The scoring table will be located near to the Train Carriage.

Once Sports Day is complete, we will walk the children back to the classrooms and we ask that you send one member of your family to collect them as you would at the end of the day. The school will then be open for Open Morning where you can walk around, visit the current classroom and teachers and introduce yourself to the next teacher. You may also want to look at your child's work over the year. Reggie's Diner will stay on site all day (menu included below) and the PTFFA will be selling ice creams during this session. If you have pre-ordered a cold lunch from our school kitchen, this will be delivered to your child's classroom. If you have ordered your lunch and no longer require it, please cancel it via School Grid. You are also welcome to bring your own picnic for the morning and take advantage of finding somewhere in our school grounds to sit and spend time together as a family. The gates will remain closed until 12.30pm when they will re-open for departure. Should you need to leave before this, please go via the main office to be signed out. School is then closed for the afternoon.

We look forward to welcoming you all to our annual celebration of our school!
