*We are now mid-way through the first term of 2026 and we thought we would share with you some of the wonderful activities that the children have been involved in.*

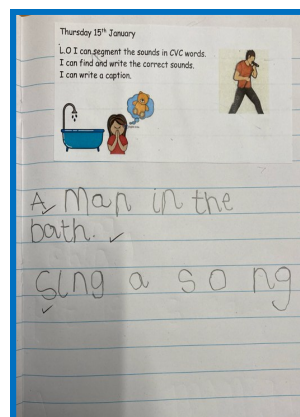
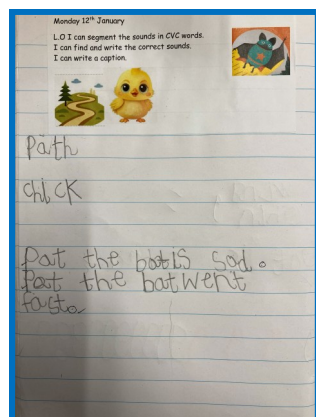
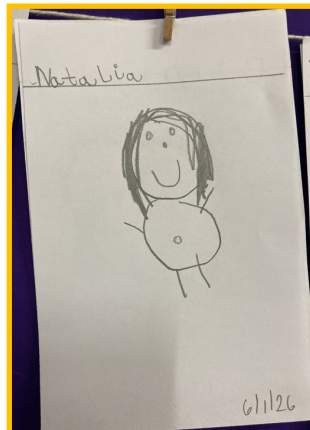
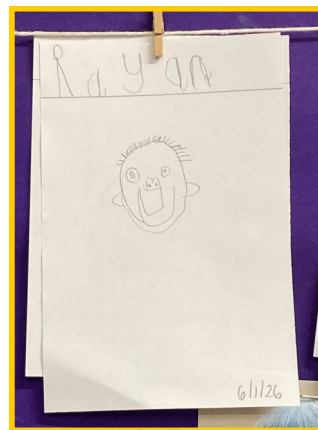
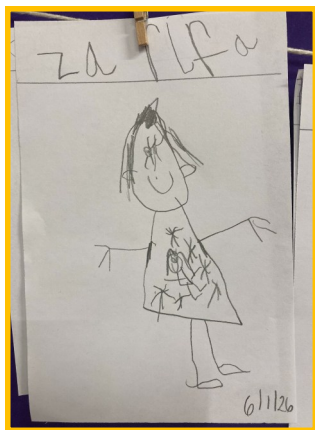
*We have been extremely lucky to have Keri Hill in to teach dance across the school and it is lovely to see the children being active, learning some actions and showing us their own individual dance moves.*

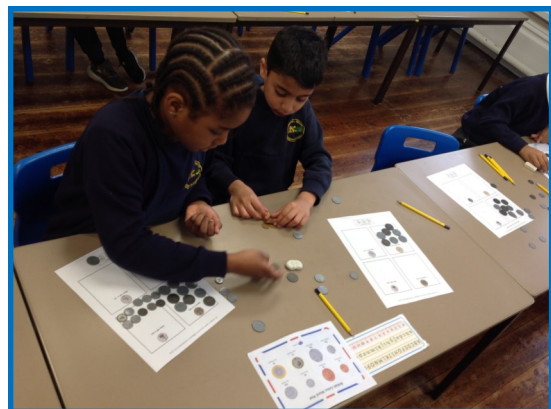
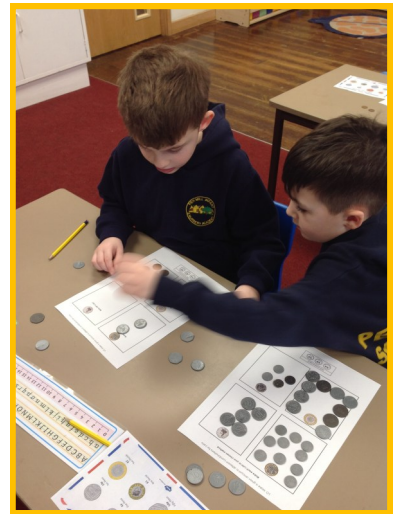
