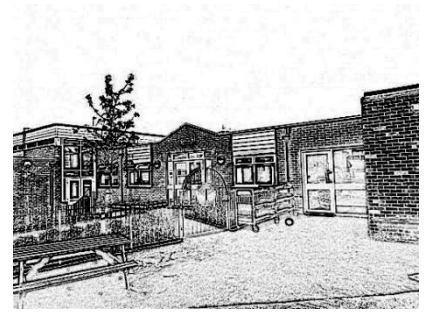

Dear Parents/Carers,

As a part of your child's education at Christ Church C of E Primary, we promote personal wellbeing and development through a comprehensive Personal, Social, Health and Economic (PSHE) education programme. PSHE education is the curriculum subject that gives children the knowledge, understanding, attitudes and practical skills to live safe, healthy, productive lives and meet their full potential.

I am writing to let you know, that next half term your child's class will be taking part in lessons which will focus on the relationships and sex education (RSE) aspect of this programme.

An important part of the Jigsaw PSHE programme is delivered through the 'Relationships' and 'Changing Me' puzzle pieces which are covered in the summer term. These lessons are all age appropriate and are delivered in a respectful and sensitive way. Next half term we will be focusing on the 'Changing Me' following on from the teaching of 'Relationships' this term.

There are four main aims of teaching RSE:

- To enable children to understand and **respect their bodies**
- To help children develop **positive and healthy relationships** appropriate to their age and development
- To support children to have **positive self-esteem** and **body image**
- To empower them to be **safe** and **safeguarded**.
