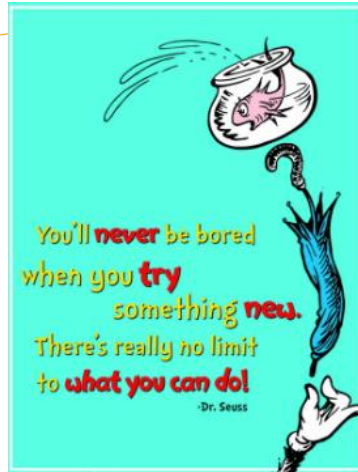

Keeping children safe in school is one of our key priorities. Our Designated Safeguarding Leads are :

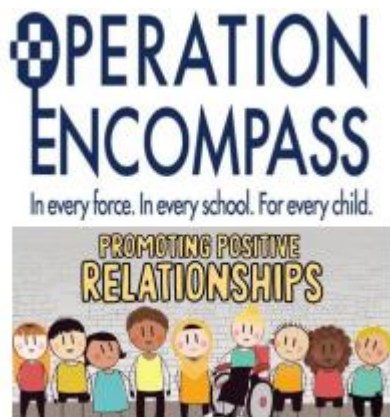

Operation Encompass

Operation Encompass has been adopted within Lancashire, to provide early reporting to schools such as ours, about all domestic abuse incidents that occur outside school hours which a young person attending Woodnook Primary has been exposed to and which then might have an impact on their schooling the following day. This information is shared throughout the year, including school holidays and weekends.
