Attendance Reminder message from our attendance lead: Miss Lilley

Regular and punctual school attendance is vital for your child's academic achievement, social development and future success. Each day of learning builds on the last and frequent absences can lead to significant gaps in understanding.

Being present at school helps children form friendships, gain confidence and feel a sense of belonging. Establishing strong attendance habits early also prepares them for the routines and responsibilities of adult life.

As per government guidance, we have been directed by our Trust that any holidays during term time cannot be authorised and we must follow Trust policy regarding reporting of unauthorised absences to the local authority, which may result in a penalty notice/fines being issued.

Other School Reminders

It is important that your child has all necessary equipment at the start of the week and each day so that they are 'school ready.'

They will need their coat, reading glasses, reading book bag (EYFS/KS1) or a small rucksack (KS2 only).

In KS2, pencil cases/personal stationary are now permitted though not required. School will always provide stationary for those that require any in lessons. Cases must be able to fit in trays or will have to remain in lockers.

Please make sure all uniform is LABELLED. (We already have new jumpers in lost property!!)

If your child has an inhaler, we must have one sent into school that can be kept in school.

School is a NUT FREE school due to children having severe allergies - no NUT products whatsoever.

Please do not send children in with fidget toys/other items unless this has been agreed with class teachers & SENCOs. We do have a range of sensory resources in school for when a need has been identified.
