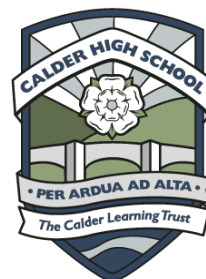
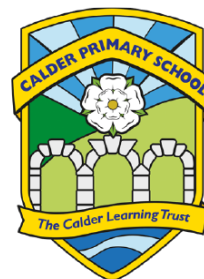

Remembrance Sunday

Dear Parents/Carers,

On Sunday 9th November, we will once again be taking part in the Hebden Royd Town Council Remembrance Parade.

We will be meeting at 1.45pm at Mytholmroyd Community Centre, with the parade then setting off at 2pm through Mytholmroyd to the cenotaph in the centre of the village.

Once we get to the cenotaph, there will be short service of Remembrance which will include some hymns and laying of wreaths. As part of the service, our Calder Primary School choir, along with the choirs from Burnley Road Academy and Scout Road Academy, will be singing on the steps.

Pupils who are not in choir are also very much welcome to join us in parading and joining the service. Once we arrive there, we will ask them to stand at the sides around the cenotaph (or with parents or families as preferred) rather than on the steps, to avoid confusion.

Please can pupils who are attending wear their school uniform and a poppy. If the weather is inclement, please also wear coats (or have coats available with parents).

Parents and families can walk alongside the parade on the pavements or meet us there to join the service.

Following the service at the cenotaph, families are welcome to then make their way home or are warmly invited to join the service at St Michael's Church. Please note that schools will not be part of the church service this year, it is an open invitation to families instead.

We know that some of our pupils will be there with scouting or other groups instead, and we look forward to seeing them in their smart uniforms!
