Dear Parents and Carers,

We are looking forward to our whole school trip to Paulton's Park and are writing to confirm the final arrangements for the day.

The current weather forecast predicts temperatures of around 25°C, so we expect it to be a very warm day. Children may attend dressed in their PE T-shirt along with suitable, comfortable bottoms appropriate for a warm day. Wearing trainers is the best idea to keep our toes safe. Please ensure clothing is lightweight and practical, allowing children to stay cool and move easily throughout the day.

What to bring

🎒 It is **very important** that all children bring a rucksack. Please **do not send plastic shopping bags or string PE bags**, as children will need to carry their belongings with them throughout the day and we will not have facilities to store bags.

Inside your rucksack, please make sure your child brings:

💧 A refillable water bottle (there are water refill stations in the park, which we will use regularly)

A sun hat (this is essential in the hot weather)

Sunscreen applied at home before leaving – we are unable to apply this in school, but you may pack sunscreen in your child's bag so they can reapply during the day

A packed lunch in a disposable bag so that children can dispose of after eating. If you have ordered a school lunch (ordering time for this has passed) your child will receive their lunch in the classroom the morning of the trip.

Please note children must not bring sweets. The combination of heat and rides may make children feel unwell, and sweets can increase this risk.

Medication

If your child requires any medication during the day, please bring this into school from tomorrow and hand it to your child's class teacher or teaching assistant. Tuesday morning is always busy and exciting, so having medication organised in advance will help ensure a smooth start to the trip.

Timings

We will leave for our coaches at 9:00am, so please ensure your child arrives at school on time.

At the end of the day, we will bring the children from the coaches back into their classrooms to be registered, in line with our safeguarding policy. Therefore, please do not wait at the coach drop-off point—instead, collect your child from their classroom as usual.

We aim to return to school at approximately 4:30pm. You will receive a text message when we have left Paulton's Park to provide a more accurate arrival time.

Thank you for your support in helping us prepare for what promises to be a fantastic day for all the children.
