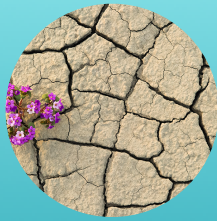

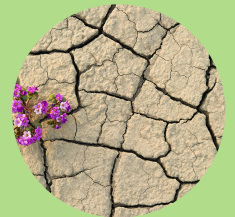
We do not hold duplicate copies of text in school and therefore rely on books being practised at home and returned.
