## **Year 6 Liddington Residential**

What a very intense and very enjoyable time. The Year 6s motored around a week's worth of activities in 3 days. They learnt **archery** skills and had a points competition, climbed a 3 storey **climbing wall** and accumulated their heights to compare to international landmarks, heard pirate **stories** and joined in with their **songs** around a camp fire, competed against each other throwing balls into hoops on trampolines in **Aeroball**, learnt how to **canoe** on a bright green lake, got harnessed up to a 2 storey **swing** and had their team mates pull them up, climbed a 2 storey **pole** and jumped off a platform trying to grab a **trapeze**, tried to protect a water balloon so it wouldn't break when thrown on the floor in **Balloon Splash**, worked together in their teams to solve problems and did 9 holes of **disc golf** through the forest.

Freetime was timetabled but there didn't seem to be any time leftover! The food was unlimited and hugely varied with the breakfast feeling very much like being at a Premier Inn. In fact, the children often referred to their accommodation as the hotel with its up to 5 person rooms with ensuite bathrooms. The activity leaders were really energetic, engaging the children with the exhilaration of the activity, songs between activities and chatting about life (and co-incidentally all but one was from Australasia). 3 days certainly felt like a week, especially on the journey home. We hope the children all had an enjoyable time and a huge thanks to all the staff who gave up their time to look after all the children throughout the trip.

She introduced her new book, *The Shell Secret* - an exciting adventure and mystery set on the Cornish coast - and captivated the children with fascinating facts about the unusual creatures that inhabit our local rock pools.

The children also got to see a space suit up close (modelled by Mr Francis!) and explored its features, design, and why it's absolutely essential for astronaut survival.



Year 3 were lucky to have another visit from Author, Kieran Larwood on Thursday to celebrate the release of his new book, *Dungeon Runners: Ocean Chase*. He led an engaging and interactive talk and the children were really excited to hear about the book and how he became an author himself. Please email the school office. <u>Do not</u> email the year group. If your child is not in school, you must notify us by leaving a message on our answer phone or by emailing office.2609@ladygrove-park.oxon.sch.uk before 9am on each day of their absence. Email is preferable as we are finding it increasingly hard to understand due to unclear messages and poor telephone signal.

Please state clearly and concisely your child's full name, class and their reason for absence - being specific about the illness or medical needs. You must inform the

	school in advance by email above, if you need to take your child for an educational setting visit, religious observance or similar. These absences will need to be pre agreed by us. No birthdays, cheaper holidays, altered holiday arrangements or similar will be agreed. In line with strict government legislation, they will be recorded as unauthorised on your child's attendance record.

### Admissions to Secondary School (Academic Year 26/27)

Year 6 parents can now apply online for secondary schools and the closing date is <u>31st October 2025</u>. To ensure your child transfers to the school that you consider most appropriate, you must apply before the closing date. Remember to:

• Apply online and on time. Without an on time application you will not get an offer on national offer day on the 2nd

March 2026. It will also reduce your chances of getting a place at your preferred school in the 2nd allocation. Deadline for applications is 31st October 2025.

- Addresses: If you are moving house or have recently moved please make sure you upload proof of address tenancy agreement or a contract of exchange document.
- **Preferences:** Provide more than one preference.
- Remember to add details of siblings. Please note that if you are applying for a place at DGS and have a son at St Birinus, this counts as a sibling and vice versa.


