This week...



This week, Year 1 held a Dot Gallery! For our enquiry we have been artists, looking at the book 'The Dot' and talking about artists that used dots in their artwork. We then created our own dotty artwork and displayed them for our parents to see. Well done Year 1, your work looks fantastic!

Year 6 had the amazing opportunity to learn all about first aid thanks to the company, Save-Yu, with Gemma and Gary. We had an amazing time learning about how to help people by giving CPR. It really uplevelled our knowledge about the processes and tools we can use to save lives, and also medication such as inhalers. We learnt what Dr ABC means - Danger, Response, Airway, Breathing and CPR. We also learnt about the recovery position. We had lots of fun practising how to tie bandages. We found out that defibrillators can help people with a chance of surviving up to 50-70% if used in time, and discovered what to do when someone is choking. We also learnt not to give anyone else our own medicine otherwise it could make the situation worse.

Notices

Attendance	If your child is not in school, you must notify us by leaving a message on our answer phone or by emailing office.2609@ladygrove-park.oxon.sch.uk before 9am on each day of their absence. Email is preferable as we are finding it increasingly hard to understand due to unclear messages and poor telephone signal. Please state clearly and concisely your child's full name, class and their reason for absence - being specific about the illness or medical needs. You must inform the school in advance by email above, if you need to take your child for an educational setting visit, religious observance or similar. These absences will need to be pre agreed by us. No birthdays, cheaper holidays, altered holiday arrangements or similar will be agreed. In line with strict government legislation, they will be recorded as unauthorised on your child's attendance record.
Parking around school at drop off and pick up times	We have received reports from several neighbours expressing concern regarding the parking situation around the school. Parking conditions on Avon Way are particularly problematic, involving vehicles parking across the junction with Ashburn Place. This issue has persisted since the start of the term. Please can we ask that you think of the safety of the children when parking and consider walking to school if you live close enough. A reminder that we are kindly permitted to use the Didcot Town Football Club car park which is very close to the school's side gate. You can walk <i>safely</i> past the surgery and across the zebra crossing to school.
Autumn Term Clubs	Thank you to everyone that registered their interest in a club this term. You will have received an email to confirm if your child has received a place at the club today. Our clubs are always very popular and quite often oversubscribed. If your child did not get a place this time, we will hold their name on the waiting list should a place become available. Admissions to Secondary School (Academic Year 26/27)

Year 6 parents can now apply online for secondary schools and the closing date is <u>31st October 2025</u>. To ensure your child transfers to the school that you consider most appropriate, you must apply before the closing date.

Remember to:

- Apply online and on time. Without an on time application you will not get an offer on national offer day on the 2nd March 2026. It will also reduce your chances of getting a place at your preferred school in the 2nd allocation. Deadline for applications is 31st October 2025.
- Addresses: If you are moving house or have recently moved please make sure you upload proof of address tenancy agreement or a contract of exchange document.
- **Preferences:** Provide more than one preference.
- Remember to add details of siblings. Please note that if you are applying for a place at DGS and have a son at St Birinus, this counts as a sibling and vice versa.


