Term Time Leave

In September 2013 the government introduced new regulations making it clear that Headteachers must not give approval for any leave of absence during term time, including holidays, unless there are exceptional circumstances.

Any requests for term time leave should be made on a leave of absence request form available from the school office and handed in at least two school weeks before the first date of the requested absence whenever possible. You must have received written authorisation before your child can be absent from school.

Parent/carers may be issued with a penalty notice fine or prosecution should leave of 5 days, or more be taken which is not authorised by the Headteacher, or where repeated incidents of leave in term time for less than 5 days occur or where the unauthorised absence contributes to wider poor attendance that meets the legal threshold. Absence deemed for the reason of unauthorised leave in term time will be marked in the register with the Attendance code G.

You may be issued with a Penalty Notice should leave be taken which is not authorised. If unpaid this could lead to prosecution under section 444(1) of The Education Act 1996.

Attendance

Please can you ensure that your child attends school regularly and punctually. The school doors open at 8:45am and registration ends at 9:00am. If your child arrives after this time they will be marked as late. Children who are persistently late soon fall behind with their learning.



Active Uniform

This is a reminder of what your child's active uniform should consist of:

- Navy blue cardigan/sweatshirt/fleece/jumper
- Light blue polo shirt / T-Shirt
- Navy blue or black Leggings, Joggers or knee length / cycle shorts for summer
- Dark coloured, sensible footwear / Trainers
- Waterproof coat (with a hood)
- No football kits
