Holidays

In September 2013 the government introduced new regulations making it clear that Headteachers must not give approval for any leave of absence during term time, including holidays, unless there are exceptional circumstances. Any requests for term time leave should be made on a leave of absence request form available from the school office and handed in at least two school weeks before the first date of the requested absence whenever possible. Head teachers are not able to authorise family holidays in term time as a holiday is not deemed to be an exceptional circumstance. These regulations become applicable once your child becomes of compulsory school age, which is the term after they are five years of age. However, this 'Leave of Absence' form should be completed even if your child is not of compulsory school age. You must have received written authorisation before your child can be absent from school. Parent/carers may be issued with a penalty notice fine or prosecution should leave of 5 days, or more be taken which is not authorised by the Headteacher, or where repeated incidents of leave in term time for less than 5 days occur or where the unauthorised absence contributes to wider poor attendance that meets the legal threshold. Absence deemed for the reason of unauthorised leave in term time will be marked in the register with the Attendance code G. You may be issued with a Penalty Notice should leave be taken which is not authorised. If unpaid this could lead to prosecution under section 444(1) of The Education Act 1996.
