Well done to the Year 6 children for completing their SATS. We appreciate the support with ensuring 100% attendance.

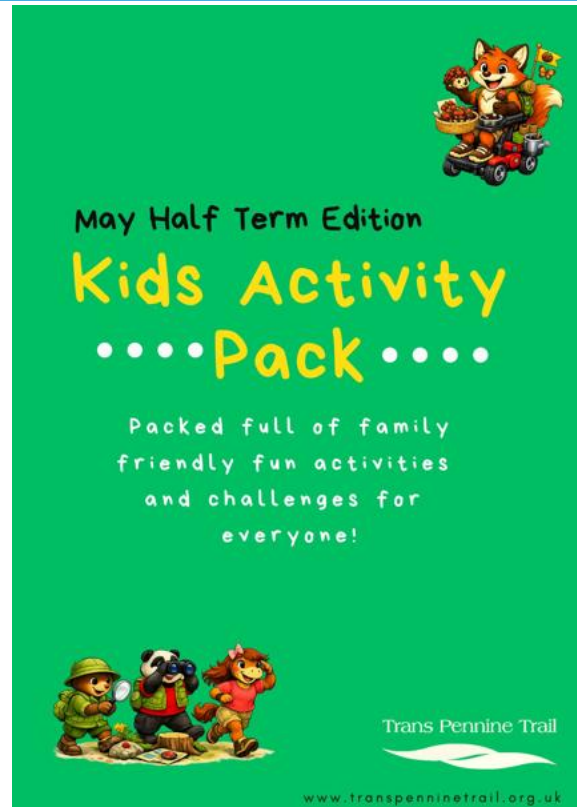
