Tuesday 9 th December	Nativity dress rehearsal to the rest of school and to some of the residents of the Vale Care Home (during normal session times).
Wednesday 10 th December	Nativity performance to parents (please collect your two tickets from the main school office)
Monday 15 th December morning	Nursery and Reception Christmas Party at Bainbridge Hall! If your child attends afternoon nursery, please bring them to the morning session instead on this day so they don't miss out on this exciting event. Please send your child wearing their party clothes. The party will end at 12 o'clock, please collect your child from Bainbridge Hall (all day children we will walk back across to school for their lunch).
Thursday 18 th December afternoon	Whole school singing at the church. If your child attends in the morning, please collect them as normal and then meet us at the church in the afternoon at 2pm.
