### [School & Eco Council Meeting](#)

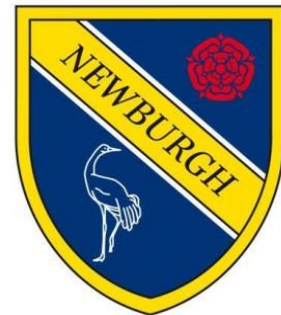
Our School and Eco Councillors will have a final celebration meeting on Tuesday at 3.30. Please give permission on ParentPay for children to attend this.
