I cannot believe that we are in the last term of another fun packed year.

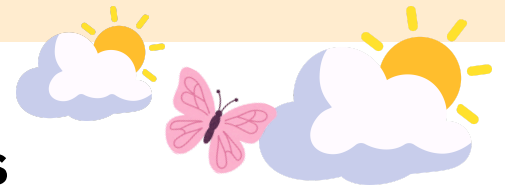
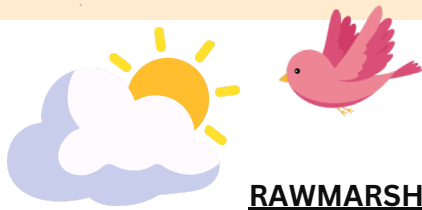

## Sickness

Your child may have snuffles and sneezes, but if they are well enough they can still come into school.

If your child has suffered from sickness and/or diarrhoea they can only return 48 hours after the last bout, and only if they are well enough to do so.

If your child needs over the counter medication e.g Calpol, they are not well enough to attend and need to recuperate in the comfort of their own home.

If your child has been prescribed antibiotics, they need to remain at home for the first 24 hours of starting them. This is to ensure they do not have an adverse reaction to the medication and to also give the medication chance to get into their system and start to work.

Please be aware if your child is absent from Nursery for longer than 5 days, we will carry out a home visit. This is to see if we can give additional support to help them return to school.

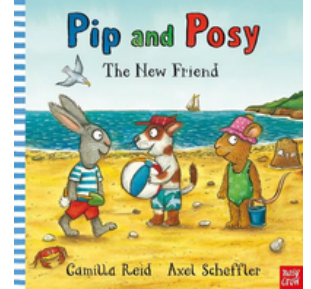
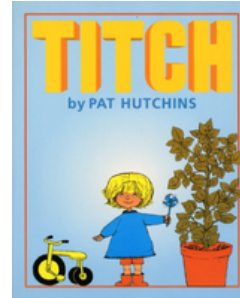
