Sickness

We often call this term the "poorly term".

Your child may have snuffles and
sneezes, but if they are well enough
they can still come into school.

If your child has suffered from sickness and/or diarrhea they can only return 48 hours after the last bout, and only if they are well enough to do so.

If your child needs over the counter medication e.g Calpol, they are not well enough to attend and need to recuperate in the comfort of their home.

If your child has been prescribed antibiotics, they need to remain at home for the first 24 hours of starting the medication. This is to ensure they do not have an adverse reaction to the medication and to also give the medication chance to get into their system and start to work.
