

Please treat our staff with respect

Wearing earrings at school

Please could we just offer a gentle reminder that unless a child has just had their ears pierced during the holidays then earrings should be removed for school, and no other jewellery should be worn. If a child has recently had ears pierced then they must be covered by tape during the school day.


