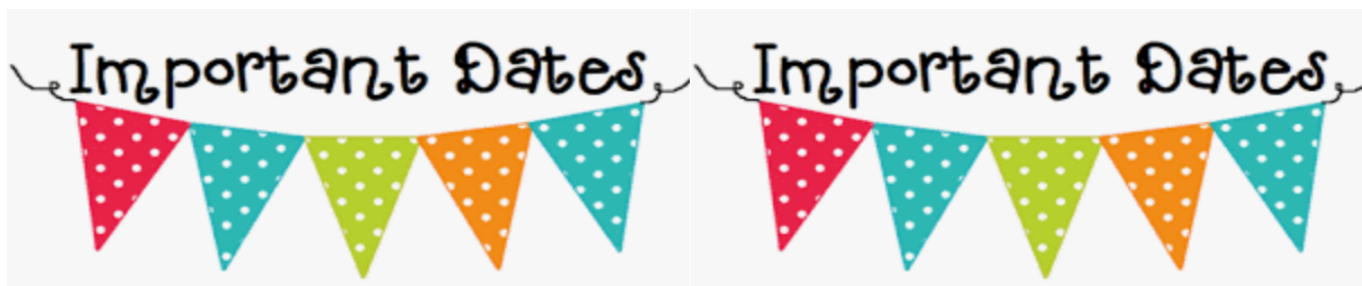

Some polite reminders for the new year:

- 1) **We are a nut free zone.** Please don't send any snacks or packed lunches containing nuts.
- 2) **Uniform:** Please ensure your child comes to school dressed in the appropriate **named school uniform everyday** and bring your PE kit in a bag because children will be changing at school.
- 3) **Drinks:** Remember a water bottle everyday, this should be filled with water, not squash. We encourage the children to regularly drink from their bottles. Regularly sipping sugary drinks causes damage to children's teeth.
- 4) **Breaktime snacks:** Fruit or vegetables please.
- 5) **Parking:** The preschool have asked us to remind everyone not to use their car park.
- 6) **Dogs:** For the wellbeing of children (and dogs) please do not bring dogs onto school grounds or tie them up just outside the gates.

We finish at 3.20, if you are going to be late, please let us know so that your child can be warned. If your child is going home with another adult, please can you inform the office because we can't let them leave without specific permission from a parent.
