Reading Homework

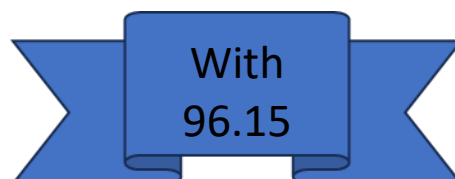
