Yn dilyn digwyddiadau dydd Llun 3 Tachwedd, mae Ysgol Gynradd Dafen bellach wedi ailagor yn llawn i bob disgybl a staff.

Penderfynwyd cadw'r ysgol ar gau ddydd Mawrth 4 Tachwedd er mwyn caniatáu i rieni wneud trefniadau amgen ar gyfer eu plant mewn pryd ar gyfer dechrau'r dydd. Dilynodd diweddariad yr Heddlu bod y risg wedi pasio yn dilyn y penderfyniad hwn.

Rwyf am roi sicrwydd i ddisgyblion, rhieni, cymuned yr ysgol a chymuned ehangach Llanelli, yn dilyn ymholiadau helaeth gan Heddlu Dyfed Powys, yr ystyrir bod unrhyw risg bosibl bellach wedi mynd heibio ac nad oes ymchwiliad yn parhau.

Mae Heddlu Dyfed Powys hefyd wedi datgan nad oes ganddynt unrhyw reswm i gredu bod risg i unrhyw un sy'n byw yn yr ardal o amgylch yr ysgol, ysgolion eraill, neu ardal ehangach Llanelli.

Rydym yn gwerthfawrogi'r pryder y bydd gennych am y sefyllfa hon ond hoffem eich sicrhau bod ysgolion yn Sir Gar yn leoliadau diogel ble rhoddir pob ystyriaeth posibl i ddiogelu lles pob plentyn ac aelod staff. Mae gan bob ysgol brosesau cadarn ar waith, gan gysylltu'n agos â Chyngor Sir Caerfyrddin ac asiantaethau eraill i sicrhau diogelwch disgyblion a staff yn ystod digwyddiadau critigol.

Os yw'ch plentyn yn bryderus am ddychwelyd i'r ysgol, cysylltwch â'r ysgol er mwyn i ni allu eich cefnogi.

Bydd patrolau arferol yr Heddlu yn parhau trwy gydol yr wythnos i dawelu'r gymuned.

Following the events of Monday 3 November, Dafen CP School has now fully re-opened to all pupils and staff. The decision was taken for the school to remain closed on Tuesday 4 November to allow parents to make alternative arrangements for their children in time for the start of the day. The Police's update that the risk was deemed to have passed followed this decision.

I want to re-assure pupils, parents, the school community and wider Llanelli community that following extensive enquiries by Dyfed Powys Police, any potential risk is now deemed to have passed and there is no ongoing investigation.

Dyfed Powys Police have also stated that they have no reason to believe there is a risk to anyone living in the area surrounding the school, other schools, or the wider Llanelli area.

We appreciate the concern you will have about this situation but want to reassure you that Schools in Carmarthenshire are safe locations where every possible consideration is given to safeguarding the wellbeing of all children and staff members. Each school has robust processes in place, linking closely with Carmarthenshire County Council and other agencies to ensure the safety of both pupils and staff during critical incidents.

If your child is anxious about returning to school, please contact the school so that we can support you.

Routine Police patrols will continue throughout the week to reassure the community.
