"When I Grow Up" dress up day

We will spend today talking about different professions and thinking about the different jobs we would like to do when we are older.

Phonics



This term the children will be learning phonics as a whole class and focussing on Set One sounds. We will be working on our skills to blend sounds together to read simple words.

Once we begin learning the correct sounds for the different phonemes we will send practice sheets home in a paper folder in your child's book bag. We would appreciate if you could review these with your child throughout the week to help with the development of their phonics understanding. Look out for an invitation to our phonics and Kinetic letters workshop within the next few weeks.

Kinetic Letters

This term we will be learning about the different positions needed to support our handwriting development and looking at holding our pencils correctly. We will learn how to form each letter correctly as we learn the sound it makes in phonics.

Mathematics

We will be exploring a range of different Maths concepts through our play in the classroom and outdoor area.


During our carpet sessions we will be practising;

Counting assortments of objects and learning to subitise.

Looking how we can sort different objects and explain our criteria for sorting them.

Begin to understand about and create repeating patterns.

ALL ABOUT ME



This term our learning will be focussed around the topic of "All About Me."

We will be learning about sharing with our friends and playing together through the text "This is Our House". We will talk about who lives in our houses with us and have a go at making different representations of houses.

We will begin talking about and understanding our feelings through the text "The Colour Monster", exploring different colours, as well as talking about things that make us feel happy, sad, angry etc.

Through our class text of Supertato the children will learn about healthy eating and super hero values such as perseverance and kindness.

Towards the end of the term we will be thinking about different professions and real-life people who help us. We will be thinking about what we would like to be when we grow up and hopefully have some visits from people in different professions to talk about their different roles and responsibilities.

Autumn Term



8:40 - Dough Disco! This helps build up our hand strength for writing, we follow the directions on screen with our own piece of Playdough.

8:50 - Register and check in - we answer our names and sometimes have a class question to discuss or we have a story that our learning will be based around.

9:10 - Free Play - This is our time to access activities in the classroom and our outdoor area, learning through our play.

10:10 - Phonics - we will be learning and reviewing our sounds we have learned so far, for every five sounds we learn we will receive a homework sheet to share with you at home.
