

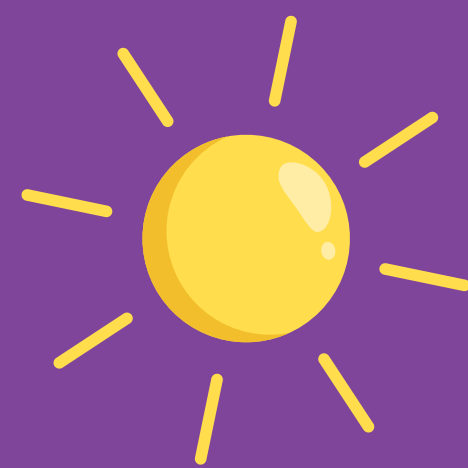

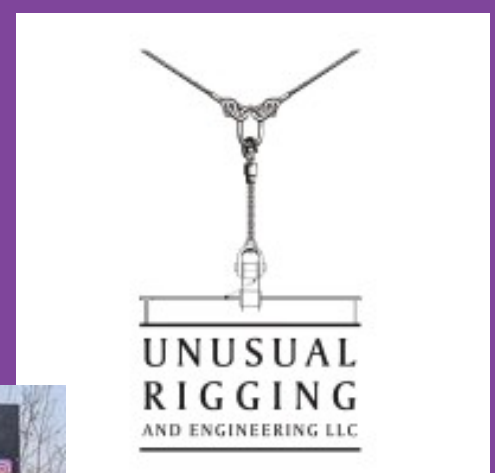

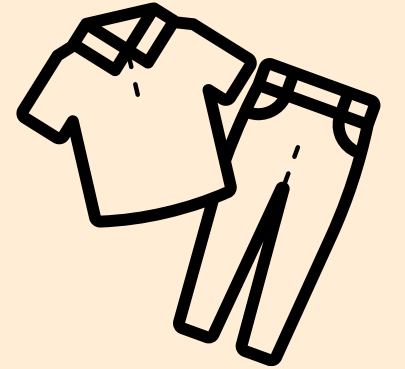




# SCHOOL UNIFORM REMINDER

School uniform is an important part of the feeling of belonging to a school and showing pride in your appearance and where you attend. Please can I remind parents/carers that the following school uniform should be worn.

- Black or grey trousers, skirts, school dresses or shorts (**This doesn't include leggings**)
- White polo shirt
- Purple school jumper or cardigan
- Black school shoes or boots - (**trainers should not be worn**)



Please support us to promote the importance of this with the children.

PE Kits - Full PE kits should be in school at all times. This includes the following:

- Plain white or house coloured t-shirt
- Black PE shorts
- Black plain tracksuit bottoms and hoodie/jumper for colder weather
- Trainers

**Jewellery is not to be worn in school**, with the exception of stud earrings and a watch (non-smart watch). We also encourage **long hair to be tied back** for school to limit distraction from learning and ensure the children's safety.
