A reminder to let you know our Year 1 class assembly will be taking place on Friday 27th March at 3pm. We look forward to seeing parents/carers and other family member there.




FoCS Easter Trail






Thank you Miss Hewertson - From Year 2

Well done to the following children, who were awarded Star of the week, this week and last week!




Reception	Todd- for being an all round superstar and having great listening skills and contributing on the carpet.


