

# **Communication with school:**

### **Urgent 5 minute queries:**

If you need a longer conversation with your child's class teacher, please contact the school office to arrange an appointment.

### Non-urgent enquiries:

## School Comms / School Gateway app:

Parents and carers must ensure they have access to School Comms and the School Gateway app. We use this app for secure text messages and emails (sensitive information including your child's data, notifications in the event of a lockdown scenario, emergency school closures etc.).

Parents must also use this app for booking and paying for dinners and breakfast and after school clubs.

# **Booking dinners and Clubs:**

Parents must book and pay for any lunches in advance using the School Gateway app.

Parents must also book and pay for breakfast and after school clubs by 3pm the day before using the School Gateway app.


Please ensure you follow this system to ensure the smooth running of our clubs and lunch provision.

No pencil cases – all stationery is provided ☺



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# **School Uniform**

# Key things to remember about our uniform and dress code:

- PLEASE LABEL EVERYTHING WITH YOUR CHILD'S NAME!
- Hair bobbles / slides etc must be blue or navy
- No large hair accessories e.g. bows are permitted
- Children come to school in their kit on PE days
- No hoodies
- PE shorts: these should be navy in colour
- No cycling shorts
- Children need to wear navy jogging bottoms and tops in the colder months
- No large logos / branding
- No makeup, nail varnish, tattoos, jewellery etc.
- Children must not wear any clothing, accessories or bring into school any items displaying political symbols, logos, slogans or images

### Water Bottles, Snacks and Packed Lunches:

- Water bottles should be no larger than 600ml
- Water only NO JUICE
- Reception and Key Stage 1 do not need to bring a snack as the school provides fruit
- Key Stage 2 may bring fruit as a snack (please do not send crisps or other unhealthy snacks)
- WE ARE A NUT FREE SCHOOL
- No chocolate or sweets permitted in school
- Drinks in the hall: the children will be given a cup and water to drink in the hall if they bring a packed lunch. Children who buy a dinner will be offered water or milk

# Mobile phones are not permitted in school.

If your child brings a phone to school, they must switch it off and hand it into the school office before coming onto the school playground.
