Holidays during term time:

Our attendance target is a minimum of 96% for every child. To reach their target, as a minimum, all children must attend school for at least 183 out of 190 school days in the year.

The target is set because evidence proves that children who attend school regularly do better in school both now and in the future. When absences due to holidays are added to absence because of illness, children's attendance percentages can drop to unacceptable levels.

There are only 190 school days in the year which leaves 175 days for leisure activities and holidays – so please do not book holidays during term time. Thank you.


