The Kingdom Season – an extract for Rev Lesley's weekly newsletter

"It is in November that we enter what is known as 'The Kingdom Season' and the colour red is used. Red is a colour reflecting the work of the Holy Spirit and the sacrifice that Jesus made on the cross. Red Poppies are used extensively at this time as a symbol of remembrance for people who have died or suffered in war or conflict. So much to remember...so much to learn from...so much that calls us to build for the future in the light of the past.

For the people of Israel, remembering was as integral part of their faith; the story of how God had delivered them from Egypt and led them safely through the wilderness to the Promised Land. A story repeated by parents year after year, to their children and children's children. The memory of Gods goodness and guidance across the years sustained, enriched, and encouraged their faith.

For Christians too, remembering has a special place. 'Do this in memory of me' said Jesus (Luke 22: 18-20; 1 Corinthians 11: 24). Such words remind us that our faith is not based on wishful thinking or idle speculation, or well-intentioned philosophy, rather it is rooted in history, in what God has done."
