
**Week 1/Week 2**


Through this silly take on 'The Wheels on the Bus,' we will explore different ways we can travel whilst listening carefully and identifying the rhyming phrases.




**Week 5/Week 6**

**Class Text:** We Catch the Bus



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## Our Repeated Reads






## Supporting Communication, Language and Comprehension

When children report on their own experiences, we use the colourful semantics cards to prompt them to answer questions more fully and with greater detail.




### Maths
