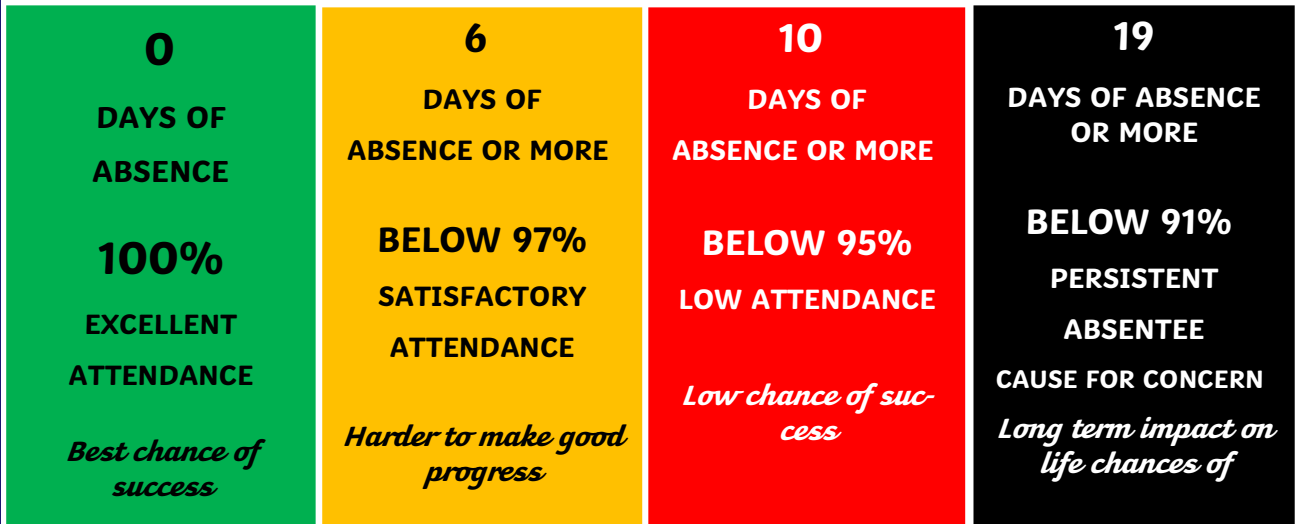

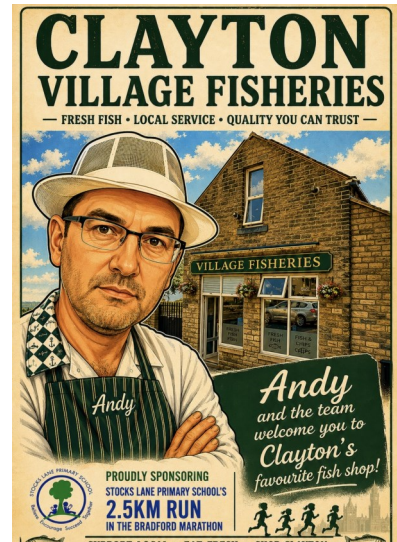
## Sponsored Bradford Marathon
