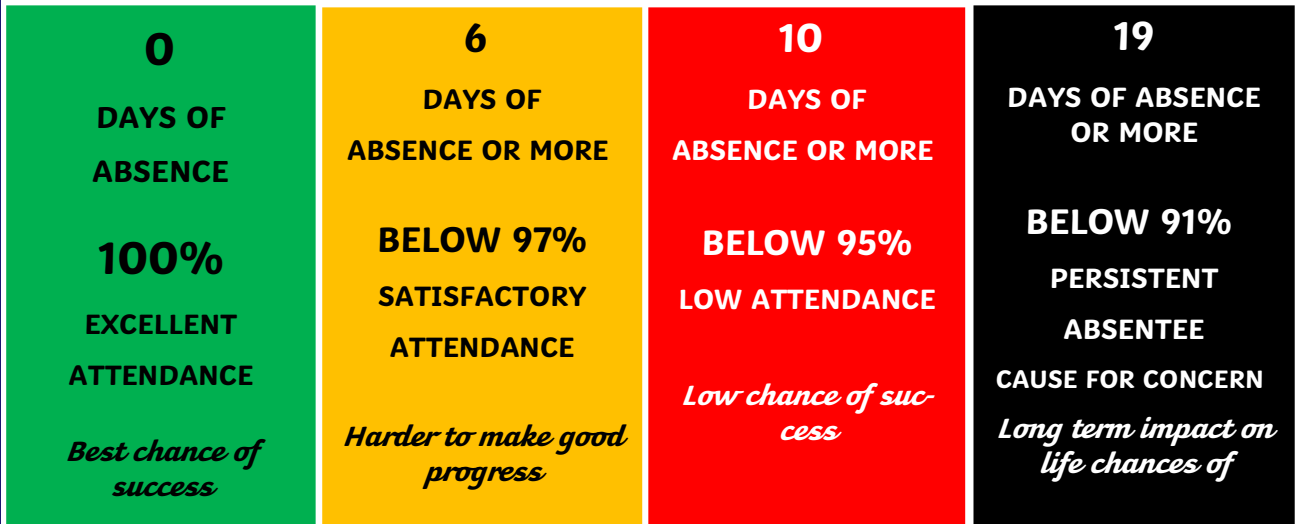

Sponsored Bradford Marathon

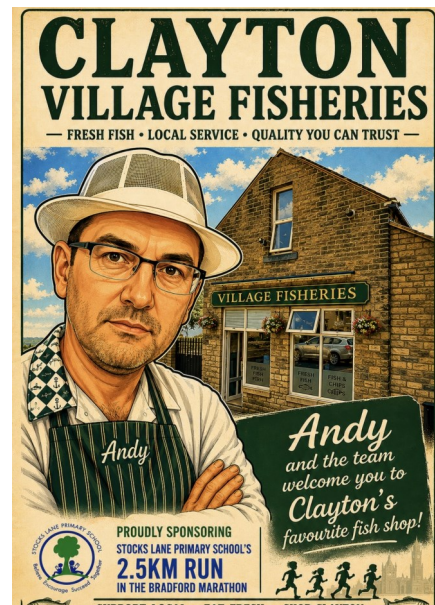

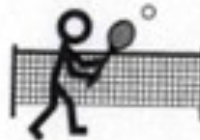

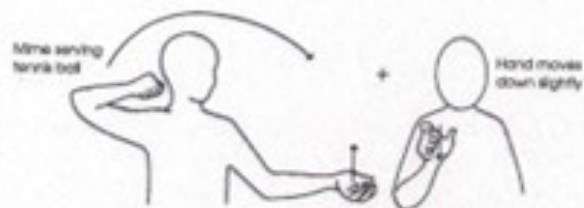
