Dear Parents, Carers and Children.

Welcome to your first term at Whitehall Primary School. We are really looking forward to getting to know you all. At the start of each term we send home a newsletter which outlines what your child will be learning. This will also feature key dates so keep an eye out for these! This term the children will be learning about their bodies and talking about themselves, their families and the things they like and dislike.

Literacy/ Phonics:

This term we will start to learn letter sounds. This will be done through daily carpet sessions where children will practise writing these too. We will also learn some common exception words that the children just need to be able to read.

We will be focusing on speaking and listening as part of our Literacy lessons. We will talk about our families, who we live with and things that are special to us. We also think about our bodies, how they work and how to keep ourselves healthy.

Maths:

In Maths we will be focussing on exploring, counting, numbers to 5. We will use lots of different resources to explore this and use our outdoor environment too. We will begin to subitise and use the language more, most, fewer, fewest to compare two groups. We will look at 2 step repeating patterns and begin to create our own. We will also spend some time exploring size, using words big and small and tall and short.
