Safeguarding

Safeguarding is everybody's responsibility. Please respect and follow our safeguarding procedures when using the gate and entrance at Oakfield Road. During school hours, do not let anyone tail gate or follow behind you and do not tail gate and follow behind anyone else when entering the school site.

Please press the buzzer, explain to the office your reason for attending and report directly to Reception. We have a camera on the gate so we are able to see you. These rules are here to protect your children and keep them safe, we do not allow anyone to wander the school grounds unless they have signed in and safeguarding checks have been completed. We will always challenge you and abuse will not be tolerated. Thank-you for your co-operation.

First Aid

Our first aid notification procedures have changed. You will now receive a text message alerting you if your child has received first aid or has been seen by a first aider. Please do not panic if you receive these text messages, they are simply an information sharing tool.

If we phone you, it may be a medical emergency that would require your immediate attention. If we could not get a hold of you, we would phone every available contact on Arbor, so please ensure these details are up-to-date.

If you would like to know more information about the first aid treatment, please speak with your child's class teacher at the end of the school day.
