Dear Parents/Carers,

On Monday 16th March **Dragonflies** will be visiting Elmswell Farm, Driffield for the morning and returning to school for their lunch.

The children will be collected from school by tractor and trailer. The specially adapted trailer will accommodate the children and adults; it is fitted with seat belts and will leave school at 9.00 a.m. and return at approximately 12.30p.m.

There will be 26 Y2 children taking part accompanied by the appropriate number of adults. As in all school activities the children should respect the authority of all the adult helpers and follow instructions at all times.

We will be walking around the farm with Farmer John who will show us the crops in the fields and his animals. **Children will need wellingtons and appropriate outdoor clothes and coats** as we will be out on the farm for all of the morning. Please can the children bring their uniform and a pair of shoes in a bag to get changed on return to school.

The trip has the approval of the full governing body and is covered by the ERYC Insurance Scheme. The staff will carry a mobile phone at all times.

If your child suffers from travel sickness or has any specific medical needs, please let us know so that appropriate arrangements can be made.
