This term we will be focusing on settling into Reception and we will be getting to know one another.


We will be getting to know more about ourselves, our families, our school, our bodies and our local area.

We will be reading lots of new books to extend our vocabulary and learn lots of new words.




We will also begin our phonic lessons - Read, Write, Inc. This is always so exciting, as we learn the sounds needed to read and write!

Willoughton Primary School Acorns Class Year 1 and 2 Autumn Term 1 – Marvellous me!

Geography

In geography, we are learning about where we live. We will be looking at different maps and what features are near us. We will also be looking at the weather.

Art

In art, we are going to learn about pop art and the artist Andy Warhol. We will be making our own pop art.

Computing

In computing, we are learning about technology all around us. We will be developing mouse skills and a computer keyboard.

Science

In science, we are learning about plants. We will be observing and naming plant parts and identify and name a variety of common wild and garden plants.

PΕ

In PE we are will be developing coordination in kicking as part of football fundamentals. and learning different ball skills.

PHSE

In PHSE we will be learning about health and wellbeing. We will be looking at ways to keep healthy and how to recognise different feelings.

RE

In RE, we are learning about these questions -What do stories from religious traditions teach about God? and What can we learn from other stories?

Music

In music we are learning about South African music – hands, feet and heart.

Maths -Year 1

In maths this term, we are learning about numbers and place value. We will be looking at one more and one less, greater than, less than and equals to. We will be learning how to use a number line and recognise numbers as words.

Maths -Year 2

In maths this term we are learning to recognise tens and ones, write numbers to 100 in words, count in twos, fives threes and tens. We will be estimating where numbers should go on a number line and know all the number bonds to 10 and 20.

English

We will be reading these books this term.



We will be learning poems about our school playground and our feelings
We will be writing stories using a beginning, middle and ending. We will be describing where we live and looking at non-fiction writing about houses.

We will learn about using exciting sentence openers, verbs and adjectives. We will be practising our reading and phonics and learning our new sounds and spellings.

Willoughton Primary School Sapling Class Year 3 & 4 Autumn Term 1 - Rock of Ages

History

We're travelling back in time to explore life in the Stone Age through to the Iron Age. We'll discover how people hunted, cooked, built homes and developed tools. Children will get the chance to compare life thousands of years ago with their own lives today.

Art

In art, we'll be looking closely at cave paintings and using drawing skills to recreate this fascinating early form of storytelling. In D.T., children will become designers and makers, creating their very own Stone Age pouch using simple textile skills.

Computing

This half-term we are learning about computing systems and networks and connecting computers. We'll explore how computers work together, how networks share information, and why this is important in our daily lives.

Science

Our science focus is Forces and Magnets. We'll become scientists, investigating how things move on different surfaces, discovering the magic of magnets, and testing which everyday materials are magnetic. There'll be lots of hands-on experiments to get us thinking like real investigators!

PΕ

This term, we'll be developing our strength and control in gymnastics and building teamwork skills through netball.

Music

In music, we'll be learning through the Charanga unit 'Mamma Mia' – singing, keeping the beat and even playing instruments to bring the music alive.

RE

In R.E. we are exploring pilgrimages. We'll learn what they are, why people of different faiths make these special journeys, and what they mean to those who take part. Children will also think about journeys and places that are special to them.

PHSE

Our PSHE lessons will focus on health and wellbeing. We'll talk about how to make healthy lifestyle choices, the importance of good habits, and strategies to keep our bodies and minds strong and positive.

Maths

In maths, we'll be building strong number skills to set us up for the year ahead. Year 3 will be exploring numbers up to 1,000, learning how to compare and order them, and becoming experts at using number lines and written methods for addition and subtraction.

Year 4 will tackle even bigger numbers up to 10,000, practise rounding, and use both written and mental strategies to solve problems.

Both year groups will also be stretching their reasoning skills through puzzles and challenges.

English We will be reading this book this term.



This term we will be diving into the world of the Stone Age! Our key texts will inspire us to write our own imaginative stories, full of description and atmosphere. We'll also be having fun with poetry and learning how to use adventurous vocabulary, fronted adverbials and exciting sentence openers to bring our writing to life. Along the way, we'll keep practising our spelling, grammar and reading skills to become confident and creative writer

Willoughton Primary School Oak Class Year 5 and 6. Autumn Term 1 – WW2

History

In History, we are learning about WW2. We will be looking at the cause of WW2 and how children lived and felt during WW2.

Art

In art, we are discovering art by L.S Lowry, we will be recreating some of his artwork using sketching techniques.

Computing

In computing, we are learning about how computers work and their networks, software's and services. Children will learn how data is stored and how different networks connect.

Science

In science, we are learning about Energy: light and reflection. Children will learn how light interacts with different surfaces to create shadows and reflections, and that it travels in straight lines.

PΕ

In PE we are will be developing our team building skills in Netball and our coordination in Tri- golf.

PHSE

In PHSE we will be learning about health and wellbeing, including why sleep is important and the role of medicines in someone's health.

RΕ

In RE, we are learning about these questions -How do people express their beliefs through worship?

Music

In music we are learning the song Happy by Will Pharrel.

Maths

In Maths we will be learning about place value, building on prior knowledge, students will work with numbers up to 1,000,000, learning to read, write, compare, order, and round them. They will also extend their understanding of Roman numerals to 1,000, including symbols D (500) and M (1,000). Children will then apply this knowledge in addition and subtraction and perform calculations with increasingly large numbers and apply these skills to solve problems

English We will be reading this book this term.



We will be reading Goodnight Mister Tom and discovering how to write a character description and writing a recount. Children will learn to incorporate figurative language such as similes and metaphors, making their writing vivid and engaging.

Guided Reading

In Guided reading we will be looking at a number of different texts and using our comprehension skills to infer meaning, summarise texts and predict events.
