



Sports Premium Report Parklea Primary School Academic Year 2024-2025

1. Introduction and Context

The PE and Sport Premium is an allocation of funding to schools to improve the quality of PE and sport provision for all pupils. This report details how Parklea Primary School has utilised this funding during the academic year 2024-2025 to enhance physical education, school sport, and active lifestyles for our pupils.

Our school believes that physical education and sport play a crucial role in developing healthy, active, and well-rounded individuals. The premium has enabled us to build upon our existing provision, ensuring all children have access to high-quality PE lessons, a wide range of sporting opportunities, and the knowledge and motivation to lead healthy lives.

2. Aims of the Sports Premium Funding

Our primary aims for the Sports Premium funding in the academic year [Year] were to:

- **Increase participation** in high-quality PE and sport across all year groups.

3. Allocation of Funding

The funding was strategically allocated across the following key areas:

CPD and Professional Development for Staff:

- Training courses for staff in specific sports
- Support from outside sports agencies
- **Cost: £9605.50**

Provision of High-Quality PE Lessons:

- Purchase of new, high-quality PE equipment
- Subscription to online PE resources/planning tools.]
- **Cost: £3391.17**

Increased Participation in Extra-Curricular Sport:

- Funding for a wider variety of after-school sports clubs
- Subsidising transport costs for inter-school competitions
- **Cost: £3968.02**

Promoting Healthy Active Lifestyles:

- Development of active breaktimes with new playground markings
- Additional terms swimming to ensure confidence in the water
- **Cost: £5069.50**

Competitive Sport and Inter-School Events:

- Purchase of school sports kits.
- **Cost: £738.00**

4. Impact on Pupils

The Sports Premium funding has had a significant positive impact on our pupils, leading to:

- All extra-curricular clubs are now full (with waiting lists).
- All children have taken part in two hours of PE lessons across the week. The quality of this experience has improved following the CPD that staff have received.
- Over 180 pupils have taken part in extra-curricular activities with a large proportion then participating in competitions.
- Over 40 pupils participated in the holiday sports club.
- We saw an increase in success in competitive events including football and table tennis.
- Increase confidence for pupils to participate in assemblies and demonstration.

- All pupils took part in sports day.

Improved Physical Literacy and Skills:

- Pupils are now able to demonstrate a greater confidence in a wider range of sports.

Enhanced Health and Wellbeing:

- Increased awareness among pupils about the importance of physical activity for health.
- Most children are extremely active during break and lunch times.

Development of Leadership and Social Skills:

- Older pupils taking on leadership roles in sports activities.
- Improved teamwork and communication observed during competitive events.

Success in Competitive Sport:

- Parklea Primary are proud that they have achieved a Gold award 2024-2025 for our approach for physical education and activities, in the School Games
- Increased number of pupils representing the school in external events.

5. Sustainability and Future Plans

The improvements made through the Sports Premium funding are designed to be sustainable beyond the current academic year.

- **Embedded CPD:** The training provided to staff has upskilled them, ensuring high-quality PE delivery will continue regardless of future funding levels.
- **New Resources:** The equipment purchased is durable and will serve the school for many years.
- **Partnerships:** Our strengthened relationships with local sports clubs and partnerships will continue to provide opportunities for pupils.

Future Plans for Academic Year 2025-2026:

For the upcoming academic year, we plan to:

- Focus on developing the PE curriculum
- Expand our extra-curricular offering to include a wider range of sports
- Further develop active breaktimes by purchasing more equipment and training play leaders.
