Sports Week 2026 – w/c 15th June

In two weeks' time, we will be celebrating our annual Sports Week - an exciting and action-packed event for all pupils across the school. Throughout the week, children in every class will take part in a wide range of Olympic and Paralympic-inspired sports, including goalball, archery, hockey, table tennis, sitting volleyball, football, synchronised swimming, swimming races, hurdles, long jump, triple jump, javelin, discus, shot put, aquathlon and duathlon.

All activities will be carefully adapted to ensure every pupil can participate and enjoy success within their class sessions.

As pupils take part, they will earn points for their House teams. At the end of the week, we will hold a special closing ceremony to award the prestigious Sports Week Cup. In addition, a selection of certificates will be presented to pupils who demonstrate outstanding commitment to the Olympic and Paralympic values of teamwork, self-belief, passion, determination, respect and honesty.

Sports Day – Wednesday 17th June 2026– at 1.15pm

As part of the week's celebrations, we are delighted to invite you to join us for our Sports Day on Wednesday afternoon. The event will begin at 1:15pm, and we would love for you to come along and support the children with plenty of enthusiasm and encouragement.

If the weather is unsettled, we will notify you by 11:00am via the Arbor app and the school website should the event need to be postponed. The reserve date is Thursday 18th June 2026 at 1:15pm.

Each class will take part in both a flat race and a relay race, ensuring that every pupil is involved. In addition, all pupils in KS1 and KS2 will have the opportunity to participate in a longer-distance race.

Please note: if your child is in Nursery and you would like them to attend Sports Day, kindly inform the Nursery team by the end of next week.

The pupils will be competing within their year groups for their House teams.

Practical arrangements for Sports Day:

- *The school gates will be opened for spectators at 1pm.*

- *The pupils will be taken out onto the field and taken back into classrooms at the end of the event by their teachers, assisted by Y6 pupils. The pupils can then be collected from their classrooms.*
