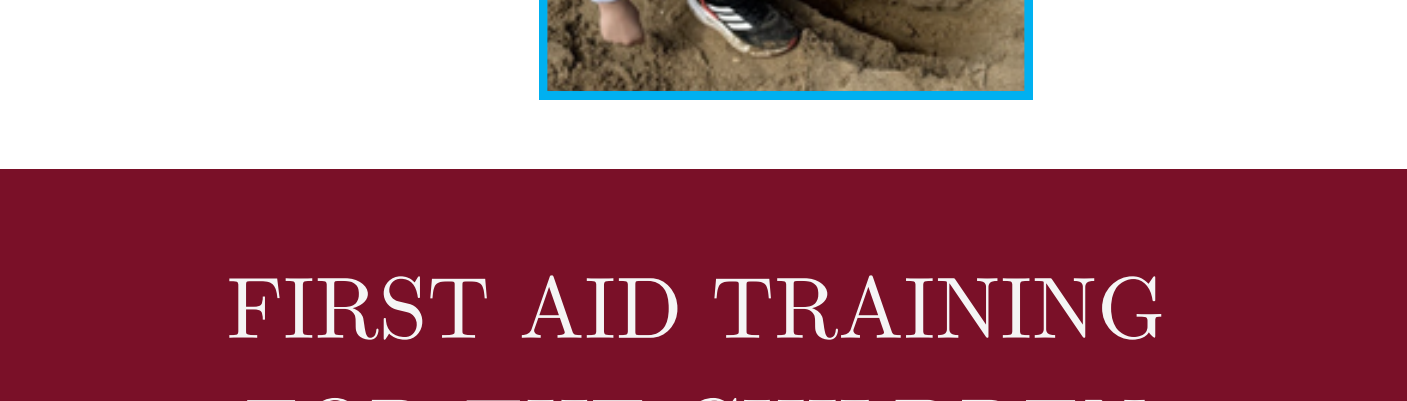
JUNE'S VALUE

There will be the opportunity to donate to the Little Princess Trust at the summer fair.

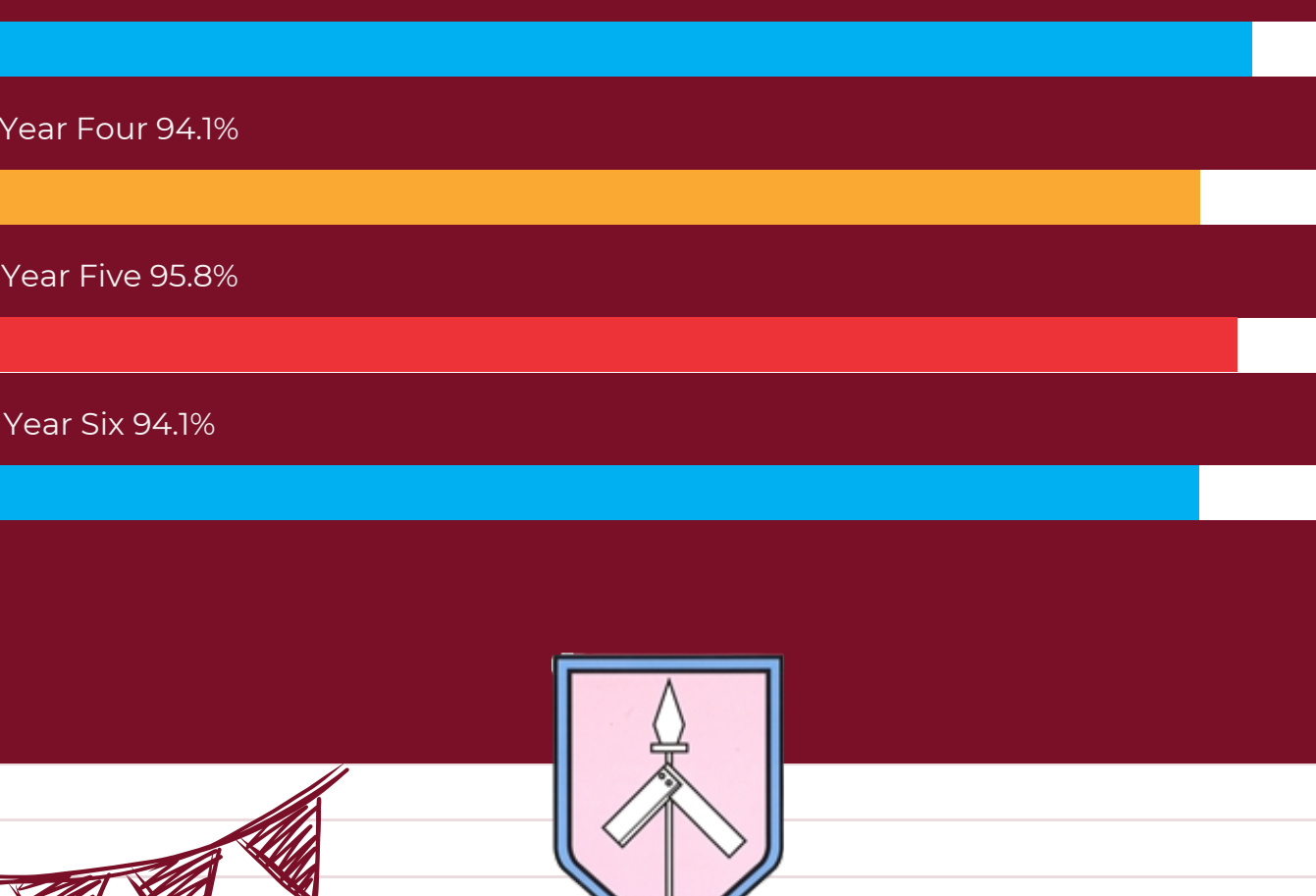

ATTENDANCE UPDATE

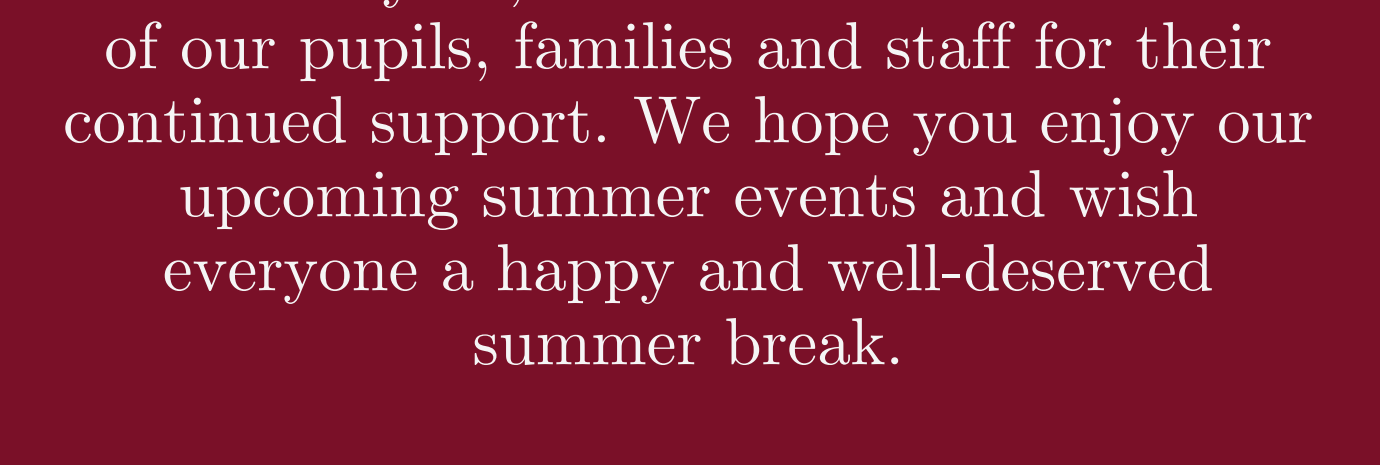
