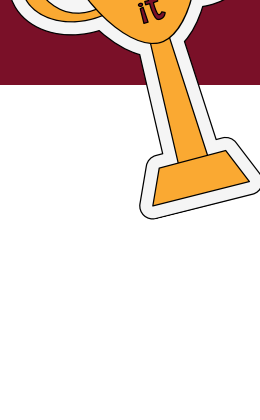
## YEAR 4 CAMPING RESIDENTIAL

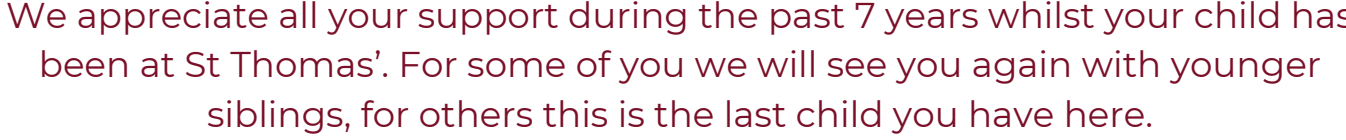
