Repairs to the large playground

The large playground is in a sorry state in places, made worse in bad weather. We are very fortunate that a large Civil Engineering company has agreed to fix some of these problems for free. This work will be carried out over Tuesday and Wednesday this week. This means that there will be some changes to how you drop off and pick up your children over these two days. Please note the following.

- Tomorrow morning (Tuesday) drop offs will be as usual.
- After 9 O'clock tomorrow morning (Tuesday) there will be no access to the front of the school or front office for 2 days.
- Tuesday and Wednesday evening, anyone entering the school from St Wilfrids Street will enter along the Nursery path and make their way to their child's classroom, passing Nursery classroom on the way. Alternatively, parents/carers may enter as usual from Royce Road.
- Tuesday and Wednesday Evening, Reception and Year 1 children are to be collected from outside the Year 2 classroom. It will be a little congested, please be patient.
- Wednesday morning, anyone entering the school from St Wilfrids Street will enter along the Nursery path and make their way to their child's classroom, passing Nursery classroom on the way. Alternatively, parents/cares may enter as usual from Royce Road. Reception and Year 1 children will enter their classrooms past Year 2.
- Children attending homework club after school on Wednesday can be collected from the usual points, but access will not be from the front of the school.
- Children attending other After-school clubs on Tuesday and Wednesday can be collected from the breakfast club door in the Nursery playground.

Please do not bring any bicycles or scooters to school on these days. Should you arrive late to school or require and further assistance please call the school office.
