School Uniform

Jewellery and Hair Accessories

On grounds of health and safety we do not allow children to wear jewellery in our school. An exception to this rule is earring studs in pierced ears. We ask children to remove these during P.E. and if they are unable to remove them, they do not wear them to school on days that they have P.E. Hair accessories should be simple and practical and, where possible, be in line with school colours e.g. red, black or white.

Can I please remind parents of our school uniform policy, particularly relating to jewellery. We are starting to see an increasing number of children in Year 6 "pushing" the rules on uniform and particularly wearing bracelets. Simply, these are not allowed.

Yesterday, Miss Chisholm and I met with Loreto High School to start the transition process for ALL Year 6 children moving to high school this year. It was a timely reminder that there will be greater consequences for children not following school rules, particularly relating to uniform, in their respective high schools.

Please help your children to follow school rules.
