Core subjects this half term

English

Reading

Our class text this half term is Letters From the Lighthouse by Emma Carroll.

Writing

Children will explore two forms: a narrative that captivates its audience and a non-chronological report linked to their history topic (WW1 & WW2). Grammar will focus on embedding skills surrounding speech and dialogue: the characterisation of characters and advancing action. Additionally, they will use passive voice to create more formal structures.

Maths

This half term children will learn to calculate the perimeter and area of various shapes; convert between different forms of measurement; and explore the world of ratio.

Our recall facts this half term continue to focus on times tables 2s through to 12s. Children can practice at home by logging on to TT Rockstars - login details are stuck into your child's reading record. Additionally, children have been provided with a set of practice cards.
