## Core subjects this half term

### English

#### Reading

Our class text this half term is *The Extraordinary Colours of Auden Dare* by Zillah Bethell.

#### Writing

Children will explore two forms: a narrative that is written from the perspective of a main character; and a persuasive letter written in a formal tone to figure of authority.

Grammar will focus on embedding skills surrounding speech and dialogue: the characterisation of characters and advancing action. Additionally, they will aim to perfect the use of subjunctive form and passive voice.

### Maths

This half term children will consolidate their knowledge on multiplication and calculation within fractions in preparation for Year 6.
